UNDERTAKING NOT TO JOIN FRATERNITY/SORORITY OR ANY UNRECOGNIZED ORGANIZATION AS PROHIBITED and CONSIDERED A SERIOUS OFFENSE based on PART V of the Rules of Conduct of THE STUDENT'S HANDBOOK San Beda College Alabang-School of Law

I certify through my signature hereunder affixed, that:

- I am made aware of Part V of the Rules of Conduct Serious Offenses of the Student's Handbook, which reads-

PART V. RULES OF CONDUCT on **Serious Offenses 2** (k) Membership in a group, fraternity, or organization one of the purposes of which is to use **violence** or **subversion** or **which employs as a part of any of its ceremonies, ritual, or other practices, any act that results in injury to any person through intimidation, intentional force, or reckless imprudence;**

The only recognized organizations in the school of Law are:

 3. The Academic Bar Operations;
 4. The Bedan Review (Law Journal);
 5. The Hotel Bar Operations
 6. The Debate Society;
 7. The Environmental Organization;
 8. The School of Law Chorale;
 9. The Legal Aid Bureau.
- I hereby declare that I am not a member of any prohibited unrecognized and unauthorized organizations or that if I am a member of any, I shall withdraw my membership therein within a week after signing this undertaking and shall not participate in the initiation rites and other prohibited activities of the organization.
 - I understand the following reasons for the prohibition against unrecognized organization:

- a) Government policies and regulations forbid the presence unrecognized or secret organization within school campuses or membership therein, especially those which employ as part of its ceremonies or other practices, any act that results in the injury or death to any person through intimidation, intentional force or reckless imprudence;
 - b) The formation of exclusive groups within the school community is disruptive of the unity and peace which the school is trying to foster among its members;
 - c) The presence of fraternities/ sororities may adversely contributed to frequent clashes among students of the San Beda College Alabang- School of Law or other schools;
 - d) In many cases, membership in such organizations resulted to the developing of hardened characters and bullies, which is contrary to the goals of the College;
 - e) The absence of fraternities/ sororities will help in the broadening of friendship among students and will eliminate the divisive effects of clannish organizations.
 - f) There are already a number of multi-faceted recognized organizations in the School of Law, which foster wholesome socialization and enrichment of leadership and personality formation.
 - g) The prohibition to join fraternities/ sororities is the institutional way of achieving its Benedictine mission and vision to establish one family of brother and sister and allowing fraternities/ sororities to flourish that will create divisiveness among the members and therefore ran counter to the Benedictine educational vision.
- I further understand that a student, who certifies **falsely** that he / she is not a member of fraternity/ sorority or any unrecognized organization, but is subsequently ascertained to be a member, shall be **excluded** from the college and I hereby agree to the imposition of this sanction.
